A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TORRANCE COUNTY TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION, LOCAL GOVERNMENT DIVISION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE LOCAL DWI GRANT AND DISTRIBUTION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Legislature enacted Section 11-6A-1 through 11-6A-6 NMSA 1978 as amended to address the serious problems of Driving While Intoxicated (DWI) in the State; and

WHEREAS, a program is established to make grant and distribution funding available to counties and municipalities for new, innovative or model programs, services or activities to prevent or reduce the incidence of DWI, alcoholism, alcohol abuse and alcohol related domestic abuse; and

WHEREAS, the Torrance County, along with participating agencies of the Torrance County DWI Planning Council, must receive approval from the Torrance County Board of County Commissioners to apply for grant and distribution funding; and

WHEREAS, Torrance County is preparing a DWI Grant application for the Department of Finance and Administration, Local Government Division for grant and distribution funding for fiscal year 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the DWI Grant application for fiscal year 2025 program funding under the regulations established by the Local Government Division is approved by the Torrance County Board of **County Commissioners**

FY2025 LDWI Application Budget

Distribution \$105, 485

Decrease of ~16,000 from last year

The Distribution total decreased by approximately \$16,000 from last year. This decrease was due to decrease in amount of alcohol tax in county as a whole and the state LDWI office is not distributing all the funds to support the cost of managing the program at a state level.

This year's distribution will only cover the salary of the DWI Program Coordinator and part of the Court Compliance Monitor salary.

More of the program will have to be funded by the grant, therefore the grant will be a much larger ask than usual.

Grant \$203,300

Increase of ~ \$103,000 from last year

Part of this increase is due to the grant covering everything outside of the distribution. Small items, such as printing, advertising, subscriptions, and dues, increased the ask.

The greatest increase is the ask for more Law Enforcement Funding for checkpoints, patrols, underage drinking, and court appearances. This is a great difference from how funding has been used in the past and a much greater expense. I have had many productive conversations with the State Police and the TCSO to increase DWI enforcement and am looking forward to this addition, if funded by LDWI.

MATCH

Distribution \$10,547.35

Grant \$20,330.00

This match requires a 10% match for each funding source, 10% for Distribution and 10% for Grant.

The match for both is being met with in-kind services that the County already pays for, including printing, salaries of the Grants Administrator, Grants Assistant, and Finance Department that support the program as part of their job, telecommunication costs, and the maintenance and fuel of both the DWI car and the Smart Choice van.

Summary

The DWI Program, and programs across the state, are at a turning point making it a prime opportunity for change. This will allow us to utilize funding more efficiently as we reprioritize DWI program components and overall program goals.
