

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, Be it further resolved that the Torrance County Commissioners have been assured by persons representing the proposed new fire district that all criteria and other pertinent requirements requested by the State Fire Marshal's Office have been met and duly recorded within that office, and

THEREFORE, The Torrance County Commission in their regular session on December 8, 1982, have agreed to establish a new rural fire district within Torrance County, and

WHEREAS, The commission is confident that the newly established district will provide needed protection to the general public and property within this district.

WE HEREBY request of the State Fire Marshal that this rural fire district be established and that a copy of the foregoing resolution be included in the minutes of the Board of County Commission of the County of Torrance as a permanent record and a copy of same resolution be forwarded to the State Fire Marshal's Office.
