

RESOLUTION: RECOGNIZING THE ESTANCIA VALLEY EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES SYSTEM

WHEREAS: Estancia Valley is a sparsely populated area with large distances to any major medical facility and;

WHEREAS: There is a need to provide a central source of information, maintain and increase the knowledge and skills of emergency medical personnel, recruit and develop potential squads within our area, serve as a focal point for the coordination and implementation of emergency medical care through the cooperation of all agencies involved, and;

WHEREAS: There is a need to develop a viable disaster plan to be implemented upon short notice in case of natural or man-made disasters, and;

WHEREAS: There is a need for a central organization which will be able to apply for grants, etc., and reduce unnecessary duplications, and;

WHEREAS: The non-profit organization referred to as the Estancia Valley Emergency Medical Services System is designed to fulfill the above-mentioned necessities and is jointly represented by the involved emergency medical, rescue, fire, public safety, and civil defense personnel.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the TORRANCE COUNTY COMMISSION herein sanction and approve the Estancia Valley Emergency Medical Services System as a non-profit organization striving to achieve the aforementioned goals.
