

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR AND GIVING NOTICE OF A SPECIAL ELECTION ON BOND QUESTION TO BE HELD WITHIN THE LIMITS OF TORRANCE COUNTY, ESTABLISHING THE DATE WHEN THE ELECTION WILL BE HELD, GIVING NOTICE OF QUESTION RELATING TO THE CREATION OF INDEBTEDNESS, AND THE DATE AND TIME OF CLOSING OF THE REGISTRATION BOOKS BY THE COUNTY CLERK AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Torrance County, New Mexico, that:

1. A special bond election shall be held on Tuesday, the 18th day of ~~June, 1985,~~ within the limits of Torrance County, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., Mountain Prevailing Time.

The following question relating to the creation of County indebtedness and the issuance of general obligation bonds of Torrance County shall be submitted to a vote of the qualified electors of the County:

Shall the County of Torrance, New Mexico issue its general obligation bonds in the total sum of \$975,000 for the purpose of securing funds to build, remodel and make additions to necessary public buildings, to-wit, a courthouse and jail within and for the County of Torrance?

2. That the Board of County Commissioners of Torrance County, New Mexico does hereby determine that the use of voting machines and absentee ballots and compliance with the Federal Voting Rights Act in said election is required.

3. That the County Clerk is hereby directed, pursuant to Section 6-15-1, NMSA, 1978 Compilation, to advise the local government division of the Department of Finance and

Administration of the presentation of this resolution and of its passage, and to attach a copy of her letter and the reply thereto to the minutes of this meeting.

4. That the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Torrance County and the County Clerk of Torrance County are authorized and directed to publish, in both English and Spanish, the following Notice of Election once each week for three consecutive weeks beginning on or before May 4, 1985 (being at least forty-five days prior to the election):
