

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Torrance County Commission, in regular session on June 29, 1988, did propose to adopt an Ordinance to impose a county fire protection excise tax of $\frac{1}{4}$ of 1% in the county area for the purpose of ambulance service and fire department capital outlay cost, and

WHEREAS, the Commission is authorized to do so pursuant to Chapter 222, Sections 1 & 2 1983 Laws, and

WHEREAS, the Commission feels there is a need to increase the revenues for these services, and

WHEREAS, this additional tax affects only those residents living outside the municipalities and only those people will be required to vote.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Torrance County Commission is hereby calling for a Special Election for the purpose of voting on this proposed tax on August 9, 1988.
