

R E S O L U T I O N No. 89-15

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Legislature passed, and the Governor signed into law, Senate Bill 77 as amended, known as Laws 1989, Chapter 25, the "Enhanced 911 Act;" and

WHEREAS, this law provides for an enhanced 911 system for reporting police, fire, and other emergency situations; and

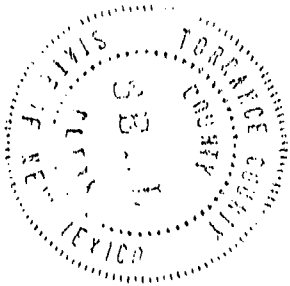
WHEREAS, the local exchange company serving a certain geographical area of Torrance County is Eastern New Mexico Rural Coop., Inc. (ENMR); and

WHEREAS, ENMR does not at present have the capability to provide enhanced 911 service for this county.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County of Torrance elects not to participate in the "enhanced 911 fund" in that section of Torrance County serviced by ENMR, at this time.


AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County of Torrance elects not to have the 911 emergency surcharge imposed on local exchange customers within this geographical area serviced by ENMR's designated 911 service area.




