WHEREAS, this resolution being duly written and executed this
 twenty-fifth day of July, 1990, declares that the State
 Highway Commission may enter into House Memorial Agreements
 with counties for the improvement of public roads; and

WHEREAS, Torrance County has the need for this assistance on its
 public roads; and

WHEREAS, the roads to be included in this agreement are as follows:
 A-113 (Windmill Road), A-102, A-102 West, and .4 mile of
 A-099, and their estimated costs are attached to this
 resolution as Exhibit A; and


WHEREAS, Torrance County Commission declares that it has the funds,

 the total cost of the proposed project available; and


WHEREAS, the Torrance County Road Department will do the majority
 of the work in-house and a portion will be contracted out.


NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Board of Commissioners of Torrance

 New Mexico State Highway Department.

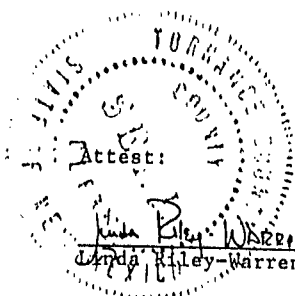
