WHEREAS, the Tri-County Drug-Free Community Committee has requested the Torrance County Commission to aid and assist in the enforcement of laws regarding sale of tobacco and alcohol to minors, and

WHEREAS, the Commission FINDS that the illegal sale of tobacco and alcohol to minors is a danger to the health, safety and welfare of Torrance County, and

WHEREAS, the Commission wishes to promote and encourage more active and vigorous enforcement of laws regarding sale of tobacco and alcohol to minors,

BE IT NOW, THEREFORE, RESOLVED that the Torrance County Commission instruct the County Manager to communicate the Commission's findings and resolution to the following law enforcement agencies:

1. Torrance County Sheriff's Office.
2. New Mexico Department of Public Safety.
3. New Mexico Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control.
4. Estancia Police Department.
5. Moriarty Police Department.
6. Mountainair Police Department.
7. Seventh Judicial District Juvenile Probation Office.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Manager be instructed to communicate the Commission's FINDINGS and RESOLUTION to each civic and service club of Torrance County, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that each agency and club be urged to join Torrance County and the Tri-County Drug-Free Community Committee in doubling their efforts to enforce laws regarding sales of tobacco and alcohol and protecting the youth of Torrance County.
