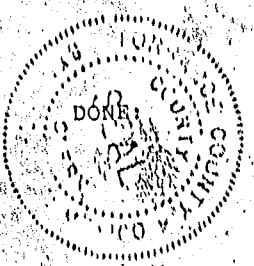

RESOLUTION 93-15

WHEREAS, the attached official document will be a county map indicating Districts A, B, and C in accordance with the provisions as set forth by the Board of County Commission, Torrance County, a total of 948.90 miles.
