

RESOLUTION 93-30

A Resolution requesting a grant be given to Torrance County for the purchase of six voting machines to enable the County Clerk to conduct elections more efficiently and to comply with the early absentee voting requirements.

WHEREAS, Torrance County now has twenty (20) AVC Advantage voting machines. All twenty (20) were used in conducting the 1992 General election. There is a need to increase the number of machines available for use in the County in order to handle the voter turnout and to comply with the early absentee voting requirements now mandated by state law.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, Torrance County, New Mexico, respectfully requests that the State Board of Finance allow the County to purchase six (6) voting machines, four (4) new AVC Advantage machines and two used Optech voting machines;

WHEREAS, the cost of the six machines would be approximately \$28,400.00, plus shipping costs on four AVC Advantage machines from New York;

WHEREAS, Torrance County is unable to purchase the machines from County funds;

THEREFORE, Be It Hereby Resolved that the Board of County Commissioners, Torrance County, New Mexico, respectfully requests approval of a grant from the Emergency Fund in the amount of \$28,400.00, plus shipping costs on four AVC Advantage machines, for the purchase of six voting machines.
