RESOLUTION # 93-4

NO SMOKING RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Torrance County knows that the smoking of tobacco is a danger to health and a health hazard to those who are present in enclosed places, and

WHEREAS, smoke from cigarettes, cigars and pipes is an irritant to many nonsmokers and can worsen allergic conditions, and

WHEREAS, smoking and the breathing of secondhand smoke can and may cause serious health problems including death, and

WHEREAS, in America, one in six deaths each year are attributed to smoking or the breathing of second hand smoke, and over 390,000 deaths each year are attributed to smoking and breathing second hand smoke, and

WHEREAS, 115,000 Americans die of heart failure due to smoking, and 106,000 Americans die of lung cancer as a result of smoking, and 31,600 Americans die of other cancers related to smoking, and 57,000 Americans die of chronic obstructive pulmonary disease related to smoking, and 27,500 Americans die of strokes related to smoking and 52,900 Americans die as a result of smoking, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens and employees of Torrance County to adopt a policy in accord with a healthier lifestyle.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Torrance County, New Mexico, that Torrance County Government be made smoke free. Effective immediately, smoking will not be allowed in any County building.
