

2. That there be appointed by each governing body, one or more Commissioners as provided, with authority to participate in the organization of the Torrance County Solid Waste Authority, and the initial appointment include the Mayors of the respective communities and the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Torrance County, in accord with Senate Bill 784 (1993).

3. That the Torrance County Solid Waste Authority possess and exercise all power and authority provided under Senate Bill 784 (1993), including the power to authorize the issuance of Revenue Bonds for the purpose of capitalizing the Torrance County Solid Waste Authority.

4. That this be deemed a joint and concurring resolution adopted by the governing bodies of Moriarty, Estancia, Mountainair, Willard and Encino and the Board of County Commissioners of Torrance County.

5. That in adopting this Joint Resolution, the governing bodies of Moriarty, Estancia, Mountainair, Willard and Encino and the Board of County Commissioners of Torrance County find and declare as follows:

(a) The preservation of the natural beauty and pristine environmental character of Torrance County will be greatly enhanced by a regular and comprehensive system of collecting, transporting and disposing of solid waste generated within the County.


(b) The escalating cost created by greater regulation of solid waste dictates it to be in the public interest for the respective municipalities and County of Torrance to organize a system of solid waste collection, transportation and disposal which will serve the entire County in an efficient and uniform manner.

(c) Each government will pledge the monies generated by its respective municipal environmental gross receipts tax for the exclusive purpose of capitalizing and operating the Torrance County Solid Waste Authority and amortizing the revenue bonds which may be issued for that purpose.

The percentage of those funds committed previous to the passage of this resolution will be exempted from this requirement.

(d) The respective governments have explored all possible mechanisms to develop and operate a solid waste collection, transportation and disposal system and have determined that the most feasible means for its accomplishment is by the municipalities of Moriarty, Estancia, Mountainair, Willard and Encino and the County of Torrance, acting by and through their respective governing bodies to participate in the Torrance County Solid Waste Authority.


PURSUANT to motion duly made, seconded and carried, the municipalities of Moriarty, Estancia, Mountainair, Willard and Encino and the County of Torrance, duly constituted and in regular meeting authorize the creation of the Torrance County Solid Waste Authority.


