COUNTY OF TORRANCE

RESOLUTION NUMBER 94-21

A resolution authorizing the county to submit an application to the Department of Finance and Administration, Local Government Division to participate in the 1994 CDBG Program.

WHEREAS, The Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program was established under title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, in order to assist communities in providing decent housing for residents, promotes economic development and maintaining a suitable living environment. The State of New Mexico estimated the 1994 appropriation of \$14,200,000 to be distributed statewide on a competitive basis, and

WHEREAS, as a result of the public input on March 14, 1994, it was decided to apply for these CDBG monies for the purpose of building a medical facility in Mountainair, Torrance County, New Mexico.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the governing body of the County of Torrance that the County Chairperson on behalf of the county is authorized to submit an application for program funding under the rules and regulations established by the Local Government Division.
