FROM: \$6,200 TO \$6,620

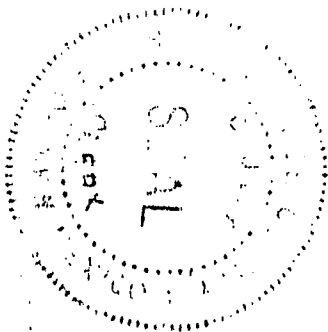
401 - 50 - 103 (SHERIFF DEPARTMENT OVERTIME)

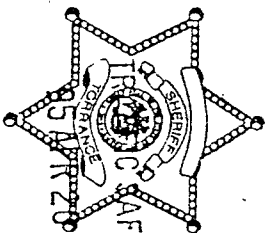

THE ADDITIONAL FUNDS AVAILABLE THROUGH THE TRAFFIC SAFETY GRANT WILL BE USED TO PURCHASE REMOTE MICROPHONES FOR SIX VIDEO CAMERAS PURCHASED BY THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT AND INSTALLED IN PATROL VEHICLES FOR DUI ENFORCEMENT.

THE USE OF THESE CAMERAS HAS DECREASED THE NUMBER OF HOURS DEPUTIES SPEND IN COURT TESTIFYING. THE ADDITION OF THE AUDIO CAPABILITY WILL FURTHER REDUCE COURT TIME AND INCREASE CONVICTION RATE AND ELIMINATE QUESTIONS OF WHAT WAS SAID IN FIELD SOBRIETY INSTRUCTIONS AND TESTING AND THE COMMENTS OF THE SUSPECTED DWI DRIVER.

THIS WILL BE A ONE TIME COST THAT WILL BENEFIT BOTH THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT AND THE COMMUNITY.

THE REMAINDER OF THE FUNDS WILL BE USED TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF HOURS DEPUTIES ARE ABLE TO SPEND IN THE SCHOOLS PROVIDING TRAFFIC SAFETY EDUCATION.
