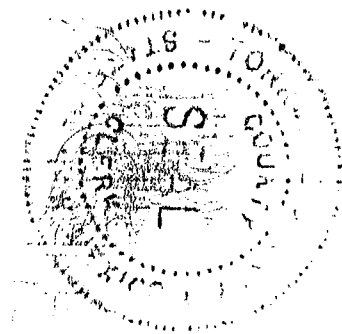



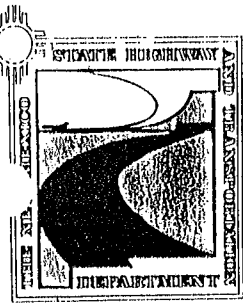

Thank you for your concerted efforts to comply with the application requirements for the Community DWI Prevention Program funding.

We have reviewed your application and the supplemental materials you have submitted. We find Activity I, as revised, to be in compliance with SHFD Rule 91-5 and the procedures and requirements of the Bureau. By this letter, you are authorized to proceed to carry out this activity for Torrance County.

Eligible and approved expenditures under the Plan during the program period (July 1, 1995, through June 30, 1996) will be reimbursed by the Traffic Safety Bureau, up to a maximum amount of \$8,143.00. Enclosed please find "POLICY AND PROCEDURES FOR MANAGING" CDWI prevention programs, including an "Activity Plan Adjustment" form which is necessary for any change in your program's activities and/or budget.

Quarterly reports are due on October 10, 1995, January 10, and April 10, 1996, and a final report is due prior to the submission of your final claim. Your final claim for expenditures under the grant must be received by the Bureau by August 31, 1996; claims received after that will not be paid without prior approval from the Traffic Safety Bureau Chief.
