A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE POLLING PLACE IN ENCINO FOR THE 1996 PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD JUNE 4, 1996.

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the Torrance County Commissioners to designate polling places in the County; and

WHEREAS, the Senior Citizens building in Encino has been used as the designated polling place for Precinct 11 in previous statewide elections; and

WHEREAS, it is expected that the Encino Senior Citizens center will be under re-modeling construction at the time of the 1996 Primary Election; and


WHEREAS, another polling place must be designated; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of Encino has been contacted regarding the use of the Encino fire station as a polling place for the 1996 Primary Election; and


