



TORRANCE COUNTY RESOLUTION # 96-24

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE SUPPORT OF THE MIDDLE RIO GRANDE REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY FEASIBILITY STUDY

WHEREAS, findings of the Middle Rio Grande Regional Transit Authority Feasibility Study indicate that transit is a promising transportation alternative for the region, and

WHEREAS, the Feasibility Study also found that establishing a regional transit authority offers the best opportunity for establishing a viable transit system for the region; and

WHEREAS, the Feasibility Study also found that state enabling legislation was required to permit the establishment of such an authority;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Torrance County Board of Commissioners supports the concept of participating in a Middle Rio Grande Regional Transit Authority and will join other jurisdictions in the region in the process of developing state enabling legislation and of preparing a service plan upon which the final decision to establish an authority will be based.

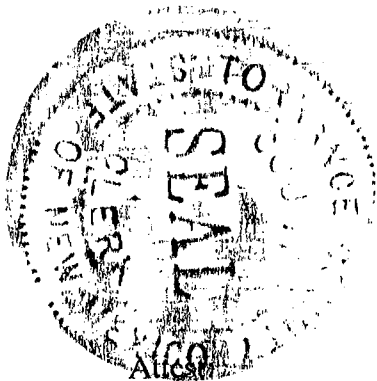
