WHEREAS, in times of scares resources, it is necessary to find new financing mechanisms and maximize the use of existing resources; and

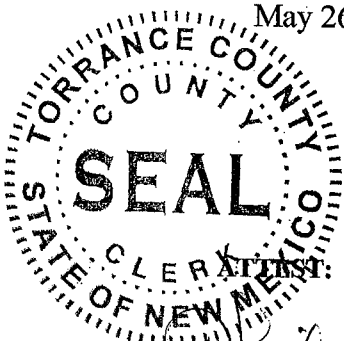
