

TORRANCE COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 2004-34

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING "WHETHER TORRANCE COUNTY SHOULD IMPOSE A COUNTYWIDE EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES GROSS RECEIPTS TAX OF ONE-FOURTH OF ONE PERCENT (.25%) ON ALL PERSONS ENGAGING IN BUSINESS IN THE COUNTY FOR THE OPERATION OF AN EMERGENCY COMMUNICATION CENTER AND/OR OPERATION OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE COUNTY."

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Board of County Commissioners of Torrance County, State of New Mexico to pass a resolution calling for the placing on the election ballot the question and;


WHEREAS, said question must be approved by a majority of the voters in the county at the general election to be held on November 2, 2004 and;


WHEREAS, this question is required to be placed on the election ballot by Section 7-20E-22, NMSA (1978 ED.).

DONE this 27th day of August, 2004, in Estancia, Torrance County, New Mexico.


