**WHEREAS:** Torrance County will with participating counties from region 2 & 5 organize, develop, and design procedures on the operational, technical, programming, monitoring, and discipline requirements detailed in the interoperability communication plan of already designated and FCC licensed radio frequencies that are identified by the Statewide Interoperability Communication Working Group and the Department of Homeland Security/ Emergency Management.


