REIMBURSEMENT FOR COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S CELL PHONE


This matter having come before the Board of County Commissioners at its regular meeting held on the 26th day of October, 2011 and the Commissioners having recognized that the duties of the County Commissioner require her availability during non-traditional office hours, including evenings and weekends, and there is a need for the Commission, County Department Heads, and, on occasion employees to contact her during said non-traditional hours. As a consequence of this need, the County Commissioner must have dependable and reliable cell phone service and rather than incur the expense of obtaining service different from that being used by the remainder of the county employees and department heads, the County Commissioner shall use her private cell phone to conduct county business and shall be reimbursed for said use at a rate of \$35.00 per month. The County Commissioner shall be solely responsible for all amounts above said amount of reimbursement, unless and only if she can demonstrate unusually high costs on her cell phone bill resulting from county business such as may be the case in fire or other natural disaster situations, in which case the Board shall consider reimbursement on a particular monthly bill.



Venessa Chavez-Gutierrez, District 1


