4 A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE FY 2024-2028
5 INFRASTRUCTURE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN (ICIP)

6 WHEREAS, the County of Torrance recognizes that the financing of public capital projects has
7 become a major concern in New Mexico and nationally; and

8 WHEREAS, in times of scarce resources, it is necessary to find new financing mechanisms and
9 maximize the use of existing resources; and

10 WHEREAS, systematic capital improvements planning is an effective tool for communities to
11 define their development needs, establish priorities and pursue concrete actions and strategies to
12 achieve necessary project development; and

13 WHEREAS, this process contributes to local and regional efforts in project identification and
14 selection in short and long range capital planning efforts.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Torrance County Board of Commissioners
16 that:

- 17 1. The county government has adopted the FY 2024-2028 Infrastructure Capital Improvement
18 Plan, and
19 2. It is intended that the Plan be a working document and is the first of many steps toward
20 improving rational, long-range capital planning and budgeting for New Mexico's infrastructure
21 3. This Resolution supersedes Resolution No. R2021-35.
