

1 Resolution along with any Early Voting locations which the County Clerk determines to
 2 maintain open on Election Day as additional Voter Convenience Centers all meet the
 3 requirements of Subsections B and C of NMSA 1978, Section 1-3-4 (2019) and will be available
 4 to voters of any precinct in the county to cast a vote at any Election Day Voting Convenience
 5 Center; *and*,

 7 **WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners finds that each polling place provides
 8 individuals with physical mobility limitations unobstructed access to at least one voting machine;
 9 *and*,

 11 **WHEREAS**, this Resolution is subject to amendment should there be precinct boundary
 12 adjustments once the final results of the 2020 Decennial Census are received by New Mexico
 13 from the Census Bureau; *and*,

 15 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 1-4-34 (2019), the Board of County
 16 Commissioners in Resolution 2021-23 appointed the Board of Registration for the County who,
 17 pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 1-4-37 (2019), shall serve a term from July 1, 2021 through
 18 June 30, 2023.

 20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of County Commissioners
 21 designates the election day polling locations for any Statewide Election to be conducted in 2022
 22 and 2023 as follows:
